PROPOSED RESCISSION

15 CSR 50-5.020 Missouri Empowerment Scholarship Accounts Program

PURPOSE: A majority of this rule is being rewritten and the prior version will be rescinded and readopted by an amendment to provide more clarity throughout the rulemaking process.
