UNCLAIMED PROPERTY QUICK TIPS FOR OLDER MISSOURIANS

1. Never provide personal or financial information to anyone you do not trust.
2. Treasurer Zweifel never charges for the return of Unclaimed Property.
3. Let your family know where you bank, if you have safe deposit boxes, where you have insurance policies and how you want to handle your estate.
4. If you receive a postcard from Treasurer Zweifel or see your name in the paper, contact Treasurer Zweifel's office to begin the claims process.
5. Sign up to receive email notifications as new Unclaimed Property matching your information is added to the system at www.ShowMeMoney.com.
6. More than 50 percent of claims can be filed online, meaning you never have to mail anything in.
7. Treasurer Zweifel receives new Unclaimed Property each week. Check your information and that of your relatives regularly.
8. Most types of Unclaimed Property are reported to Treasurer Zweifel after the company has been unable to locate the owner for five years.
9. Unclaimed Property is made up of life insurance, uncashed checks, utility deposits, savings and checking accounts, certificates of deposit, safe deposit box contents, stocks and mutual funds. Treasurer Zweifel does not handle real property such as land and houses or certain types of personal property such as cars and boats.

About Treasurer Zweifel's Unclaimed Property

State law requires financial institutions, insurance companies, public agencies and other business entities to turn over assets to Treasurer Zweifel that belong to a customer, client, employee or other owner if there have been no documented transactions or contact with the owner for five or more years. Most Unclaimed Property consists of cash from bank accounts, stocks, bonds and contents of safe deposit boxes that have been abandoned. It also can include uncollected insurance policy proceeds, government refunds, utility deposits and wages from past jobs. Treasurer Zweifel does not handle real property such as land and houses or certain types of personal property such as cars and boats. There is \$700 million in Unclaimed Property maintained by Treasurer Zweifel. Treasurer Zweifel never charges for the return of Unclaimed Property.
